Field Rules

1. Please observe the current AMA Flight Safety Code! See: <http://www.modelaircraft.org/PDF-files/105.pdf>
 - a.. No flying behind the flight line unless the aircraft is out of control.
 - b. No aircraft will be flown without first being range checked for radio problems.
 - c. When starting your aircraft, please try not to blow your exhaust on spectators, cars and other aircraft.
 - d. All flyers must have AMA insurance to fly at this site!
2. At the request of the Forestry Service, please refrain from the use of smoking materials while on this facility.
3. Flight Hours are from 5:00 PM until dark Monday through Friday. Anytime after 9:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday and on State Holidays. This is in compliance with an agreement we made with the Forestry Service. This is their main business office location. Anyone flying outside of these hours is subject to a fine and/or expulsion from the club.
- 4 Site Security is our responsibility! When we enter the field, please close the gate behind you and re-lock it. Be sure, if you're the last one to leave, to make sure no unauthorized cars are in the facility. If there are, you need to ask them to move their vehicles outside the gate and LOCK it behind them. They can walk in as much as they want. Be aware that sometimes Forestry employees use this facility on weekends and they have keys to a different lock on the same gate.
5. Please take your trash away with you. This is something else that will cost us the use of this site.
6. An effective muffler must be used on all aircraft engines flown at the club. No open exhausts or "exhaust shutter" systems are allowed.
7. Keep a watchful eye out for full-size aircraft. There are a couple of pilots that use the lake for aerobatic flying and don't consider the fact that we are here.
8. No playing "Tag" with the birds! Bald Eagles fly around our site and will sometimes try to fly with the aircraft. If this happens, get away from them even if it means landing for a few minutes.
9. BEFORE turning on any radios, make sure that your frequency is clear. ASK, ASK, ASK and CHECK the FREQUENCY BOARD. Place ONLY your FlyingTiger membership card in the frequency slot. AMA cards are not proof of club membership!

10. This is a family oriented club. Please refrain from the use of vulgar language and profanity in the presence of spouses or kids.
11. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES!!!! Aircraft and alcoholic beverages do not mix!!
12. Please help less experienced flyers when they need help. This sport will fizzle out and die if new people don't learn to enjoy the pleasures of Model Flying.
13. Greet and Welcome visitors who may come to this site. Nothing is more discouraging to a potential member or a visiting flyer than to be ignored when they come to our field. Think about how you would feel!
14. Encourage any new flyers to observe our rules. We don't want to give the Forestry Service or the Corps of Engineers any reason to ask our club to leave this beautiful flying site.
15. To report an emergency: Dial 911 or 1-800-672-4000. This should put you through to Chatham County Communications. The field location will be the FORESTRY SERVICE REGIONAL HEADQUARTERS on Big Woods Road. Chatham County Sheriff, North Chatham Volunteer Fire Department, and East Chatham Rescue Squad will be the responding agency. Cellular phone usage may be utilized but the signal could be very weak.
16. Only Club members may use the field. Members ONLY may drive down to the field and park in the parking area. Guests or spectators must park their vehicles outside the gate.
17. Only Approved (Trained/Signed off) members may fly model aircraft at the field. Trainees may fly only under the direct supervision of an instructor.
18. Club membership does not grant any other field privileges. Activities which are specifically NOT allowed include, but are not limited to: ATV's, swimming, boating, kayaking, canoeing, hiking, camping, cycling, motorcycling, and anything else which is other than flying model aircraft.
